4 minute easy assembly



1) Lay the planter on a flat surface with the smooth side up as shown.



4) Start to form the buckle clips by inserting the tongue into the nearside of the slot.



7) Continue to snap in the buckle clips along the length of the planter.



9) To form the base, fold down the triangular tabs whilst keeping the side tabs upright.



12) Next unpack the planting cups noting the edge and base slits.



15) Finally fit the remainder of the planting cups to complete the assembly.



2) Start to form a cylinder by bringing the far edge over towards the near edge



5) Then insert the edge tab into the far end of the slot



3) Keeping the planter square, continue forming the cylinder.



6) The buckle clip will then snap into place.



8) With all the buckle clips in place, you have formed the body of the planter.



10) Then fold the base over and snap in the buckle clip to hold it in place.



13) With the smooth side inward and the base slit at the bottom, slide the edge slits into the top corners of a planter cutout.



16) Congratulations! YOUR planter is now ready for use.



11) To finish the base, fold over the side tabs and secure the two buckle clips.



14) Then snap the base slit into the tab at the bottom to secure the planting cup in place.

Your planter can be secured to a vertical support using an appropriate screw.

For a balcony or railing, use a cable tie.

The generous openings in your planter will accommodate most nursery plug plants.

We recommend the use of peat free compost

For best results use a liquid feed weekly.
